



POSITION: Crisis Intervention Associate's or Bachelor's Level Intern
SUPERVISOR(S): Community Training Coordinator
TIME FRAME: Minimum Commitment of 6 Months

QUALIFICATIONS:

The Bachelor or Associate level intern shall be enrolled in a 2 or 4-year university or college social work, counseling, psychology, or related program. This intern shall demonstrate: competency in working with people from different cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds; ability to work independently and as a part of team; and ability to communicate effectively with colleagues and clients. Experience working with youth and families is preferred.

OVERVIEW OF POSITION:

This position is responsible for assisting in the provision of crisis intervention services.

DESCRIPTION OF GENERAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The following are general responsibilities of the position after demonstrated competency and sufficient preparation:

- Complete 38 hour crisis intervention training
- Complete two or three weekly 3 or 4-hour shifts on the agency's crisis line, providing telephone crisis intervention and referral services to youth, families, and others in need
- Complete follow-up calls to youth and their families who have exited services within the past 12 months
- Complete appropriate paperwork
- Assist with the updating of the agency's referral binders
- Attend all ongoing in-service crisis intervention trainings/meetings
- Complete other duties, as assigned by supervisor
