



POSITION: QueerZone Master's Level Intern
SUPERVISOR(S): Director of Clinical Services or Designee
TIME FRAME: 16+ Month Track/1 Year Commitment

QUALIFICATIONS:

The Master's level intern shall be enrolled in a graduate social work, counseling, psychology, or related program. This intern shall demonstrate: competency in working with people from different cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds; ability to work independently and as a part of team; demonstrated competence and experience working with youth who identify as LGBTQ; and ability to communicate effectively with colleagues and clients. At least one year experience working with youth and families is preferred.

OVERVIEW OF POSITION:

This position is responsible for assisting with the coordination and implementation of the QueerZone program.

DESCRIPTION OF GENERAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The following are general responsibilities of the position after demonstrated competency and sufficient preparation:

- Complete at least one 4-hour shift per week during the Queerzone program, including crisis intervention and information and referral services to youth, families, and others in need
- Assist with the development of QueerZone materials
- Co-facilitate the weekly QueerZone program
- Attend community events with QueerZone participants
- Develop weekly evaluation reports
- Participate in supervision meetings as scheduled
- Complete other duties, as assigned by supervisor
