This month, the **Ozone House Youth Drop-in Center** (734-485-2222) moves from its Huron Street location – where it has been since 1999 – to snazzy new digs at 102 N. Hamilton Street, a stone's toss from the Blake Transit Center. The Drop-in Center will continue to host programs such as Lyricist Lounge, Project Speak-out, Poetry in the Park and Ballin' in the Willow but will also house Ozone House's newly launched YouthBuild, an eight-month paid construction training program.
